THAILAND

One of the professors (a believer) said that this was the first time anyone had shared the Christmas story and gospel with professors there.

MYANMAR OCTOBER 29 - NOVEMBER 10, 2019



It was a great blessing to spend almost two weeks ministering in Myanmar. My first stop was Yangon where I led a discipleship training event for pastors and ministry leaders who serve all over the city and in its surrounding rural communities. Then, I shared the gospel in a traditional Burmese home at "KT Village" north of the city. We will be providing an interest free loan to help one of the few followers of Christ in that village to be able to support her family as she starts to make disciples there. After that, I traveled north to the city of Pyin Oo Lwin to visit a ministry partner and share in his church. Then, we traveled together to the city of Magway to lead a discipleship training seminar for pastors and church leaders throughout that province. Magway is one of the most unreached areas of Myanmar, and disciple makers there face significant opposition. It was a blessing to hear their stories and provide encouragement. One of our partners from the Philippines also joined me on this trip.







PENANG, MALAYSIA NOVEMBER 21-23, 2019



It was a great blessing to visit friends and ministry partners in Penang. Over three days, I had six meetings with Malaysians and missionaries who are faithfully serving the Lord there. It was good to hear their stories and exchange ideas with them about life and ministry. We are praying that God opens doors to expand our ministry network beyond Penang as well as looking for ways to strengthen our relationships with the people we already partner with.

TAIWANDECEMBER 27-30, 2019

We took a family vacation to Taichung City and Taipei, Taiwan to visit good friends who minister there. Our friends were excellent hosts who introduced us to several beautiful and interesting places in their city and in the surrounding area. It was a good time to both relax and to reflect upon the goodness of God that has been poured out on both of our families. It was also encouraging to be able to share with one another some of the challenges we face as we have similar ministries.



EAST JAVA, INDONESIA JANUARY 9-12, 2020



During this short trip, I shared a devotional with the staff of a social foundation, met with ministry partners, and led a retreat for men and women who share the love of Christ with thousands of poor and oppressed people in the city of Surabaya. We discussed how we can invest our time in pursuing long-term transformation, which can only happen as people enter into true relationship with Jesus Christ. This can be challenging in the often hostile religious context of Indonesia.

PHILIPPINES

JANUARY 28 - FEBRUARY 4, 2020



The primary purpose of this trip was to facilitate a small business training event for believers from three provinces of the Philippines in partnership with friends from World Ventures. This training helps disciple-makers understand the process of setting up small businesses that can support their families and ministries. Three of our ministry partners from Indonesia also joined this training. In addition to facilitating this seminar, I also shared at a church in Angeles City, met with a group of pastors from Pampanga Province and spent many hours coaching and making plans with our ministry partners.
